It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 25-1 of the General Laws entitled "Holidays" is hereby amended

2 by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>25-1-10. Holiday symbols protected. -- No city or town, or any department or political</u>

4 subdivisions thereof, may adopt, enact, impose or promote any ordinance, rule, regulation, policy

5 or protocol which requires the alterations of the name or concept of any religious or secular

6 holiday or any religions or secular figure or symbol associated with any such holiday.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
