It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 42-112-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-112 entitled "The
- 2 Civil Rights Act of 1990" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>42-112-2. Civil liability. --</u> A person whose rights under the provision of section 42-112-
- 4 1 have been violated may commence a civil action for injunctive and other appropriate equitable
- 5 relief, and for the award of compensatory and exemplary damages, within three (3) years after the
- 6 <u>occurrence of the alleged violation of this chapter</u>. An aggrieved person who prevails in an action
- 7 authorized by this section, in addition to other damages, is entitled to an award of the costs of the
- 8 litigation and reasonable attorneys' fees in an amount to be fixed by the court.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
