#### RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- COMPUTER CRIME

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-52-4.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-52 entitled "Computer
 Crime" is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-52-4.2. Cyberstalking and cyberharassment prohibited. -- (a) Whoever transmits 3 4 any communication by computer or other electronic device to any person or causes any person to 5 be contacted or who posts any information on a website or network for the sole purpose of harassing that person or his or her family is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a 6 7 fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500), by imprisonment for not more than one year, or both. For the purpose of this section, "harassing" means any knowing and willful course of 8 9 conduct directed at a specific person which seriously alarms, annoys, or bothers the person, and 10 which serves no legitimate purpose. The course of conduct must be of a kind that would cause a 11 reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress, or be in fear of bodily injury. "Course 12 of conduct" means a pattern of conduct composed of a series of acts over a period of time, 13 evidencing a continuity of purpose. Constitutionally protected activity is not included within the 14 meaning of "course of conduct." "harassing." 15 (b) A second or subsequent conviction under subsection (a) of this section shall be

deemed a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than two (2) years, by a fine of not
more than six thousand dollars (\$6,000), or both.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
