It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows: 1 SECTION 1. Section 3-8-11.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 3-8 entitled "Regulation of 2 Sales" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 3-8-11.1. Furnishing or procurement of alcoholic beverages for underage persons. --4 (a) As used in this section: (1) "furnish" means to provide with, supply, give or purchase; 5 (2) "procure" means to get possession of, obtain by particular care and effort; and (3) "permit" means to give permission for, or approval of, the possession or consumption of an alcoholic 6 7 beverage by any form of conduct, that would cause a reasonable person to believe that permission 8 or approval has been given. 9 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section it is unlawful for any 10 person twenty one (21) years of age or older: 11 (1) to To purchase from any licensee or any employee of a licensee any alcoholic 12 beverage for the sale, delivery, service of or giving away to, any person who has not reached his 13 or her twenty-first (21st) birthday; 14 (2) to To purchase from any licensee or any employee of any licensee any alcoholic 15 beverage with the intent to cause or permit said alcoholic beverage to be sold, or given to any

- (3) to To knowingly furnish any alcoholic beverage for the sale, delivery, service of or giving to any person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday;
- 19 (4) to To procure alcoholic beverages for the sale, delivery, service of or giving to any

person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday;

- 1 person who has not reached his or her twenty-first (21st) birthday; or
- 2 (5) to To otherwise permit the consumption of alcohol by underaged persons in his or her residence or on his or her real property.
- 4 (c) This section does not apply to use, consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages
- 5 by an underage person or a minor for religious purposes; or to a parent or legal guardian
- 6 procuring or furnishing alcohol to, or permitting the consumption of alcohol by, his or her
- 7 <u>underage or minor child or ward in the parent's or legal guardian's own home and under the</u>
- 8 parent's or legal guardian's supervision.
- 9 (d) Any person who violates this section will be subject to the penalties provided in section 3-8-11.2.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
