- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), records of the family court pertaining to delinquency or waywardness proceedings shall be open to inspection and copying at any time by the custodial parent, guardian or attorney of the juvenile involved, upon submission to the court clerk of a written release signed by the parent or guardian of the juvenile authorizing such inspection and copying, and upon payment of any copying costs charged in accordance with
