It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 17-1 of the General Laws entitled "General Provisions" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>17-1-11. Local terms of office. -- Commencing on January 1, 2017, notwithstanding any</u>
- 4 charter, ordinance, public or general law provision to the contrary, all terms of office for all city
- 5 and town elected officials shall be four (4) years, unless the governing body of a municipality
- 6 votes not to follow the mandatory four (4) year term for its local elected officials.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

This act would create a uniform term of office for all local elected officials of four (4)
years, unless a city or town or governing body votes not to follow the mandatory four (4) year
