It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 45-2-3.3 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-2 entitled "General
- 2 Powers" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>45-2-3.3. Background checks. --</u> Notwithstanding any <u>provision of the general or public</u>
- 4 law to the contrary, any municipal recreation department may request a background check from
- 5 their local police department for any employee or volunteer serving their community provided,
- 6 further, any fire department or fire district located in the Town of Burrillville may request a
- 7 <u>background check pursuant to this section for any employee or volunteer performing services for</u>
- 8 the fire department or fire district.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
