It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 9-31 of the General Laws entitled "Governmental Tort Liability" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>9-31-3.1. Tort liability restrictions Town, city or fire districts. -- A city, town, or fire</u>
- 4 district employee or official may be sued in his or her individual capacity, only if it can be
- 5 established that his or her act or omission, upon which the cause of action was based, was not
- 6 performed within the scope of his or her employment or it involved actual fraud, malice or willful
- 7 <u>misconduct.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
