It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Commerce
- 2 Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
 - 42-64-40. Workers' compensation subsidy program. (a) The director, in cooperation
- 4 with the director of labor and training, shall establish a program that offers businesses with ten
- 5 (10) or less employees a subsidy to assist in the payment of workers' compensation insurance
- 6 coverage for newly hired apprentices during their first year of employment.
- 7 (b) The sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) shall be appropriated to cover the cost of
- 8 <u>this program.</u>
