It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 42-62 of the General Laws entitled "Catastrophic Health Insurance
- 2 Plan Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-62-13.2. Insurance rates tied to the consumer price index. -- Notwithstanding any</u>
- 4 provisions of the general laws to the contrary, any increase in rates proposed to be charged by an
- 5 insurer licensed to provide health insurance in the state shall be no greater than the percentage
- 6 increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) as published by the
- 7 <u>United States Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics determined as of September 30 of</u>
- 8 the prior calendar year.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
