It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 1 of the General Laws entitled "AERONAUTICS" is hereby amended

- 2 by adding thereto the following chapter:
- 3 <u>CHAPTER 8</u>
 4 <u>UNPILOTED AERIAL VEHICLES</u>
 5 <u>1-8-1. Exclusive aerial regulations. The state of Rhode Island shall have exclusive</u>
 6 legal authority to regulate any object capable of flying, which is remotely controlled, flies
 7 autonomously through software controlled flight plans embedded in the objects' system by a
 8 global position system, commonly known as unpiloted aerial vehicles, remotely piloted aircraft,
- 9 drones, or unmanned aircraft systems.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
