It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 45-22.2 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island 2 Comprehensive Planning and Land Use Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following

3 section:

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45-22.2-13.1. Moratorium - Charlestown. - (a) The general assembly finds that the 4

municipal officials of the town of Charlestown charged with updating the town's comprehensive

plan would be unreasonably burdened if at the same time they are required to review

comprehensive permit applications under chapter 53 of this title.

8 (b) The town of Charlestown is granted a moratorium until June 1, 2016, commencing

with the effective date of this section, during which it shall not be required to entertain, receive or 9

10 consider comprehensive permit applications from for-profit developers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 11
