- 3 <u>42-64.17-2. Exemptions. The towns of Coventry, East Greenwich and West Greenwich</u>
- 4 are exempt from all the provisions set forth in § 42-64.17-1 pursuant to which policies and
- 5 <u>obligations may be established.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
