It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-18 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Public Transit
- 2 Authority" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **39-18-4.2. Safe turn alert systems.**

- 4 Notwithstanding any state law, regulation or policy to the contrary, no safe turn alert
- 5 system used in the operation of a motor bus that voices messages such as "Caution! The bus is
- 6 <u>turning</u>", shall be utilized in any residential neighborhood in the state.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

- 1 This act would prohibit the use of safe turn alert systems, used in the operation of a motor
- 2 bus that voices messages such as "Caution! The bus is turning", in any residential neighborhood.
 - This act would take effect upon passage.
