It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

### 3 <u>16-21-37. Sun safety.</u>

- 4 (a) Any person including, but not limited to, students, parents or school personnel may
- 5 possess and use a topical sunscreen product without a physician's note or prescription while on
- 6 school property or at a school-related event, or activity, to avoid overexposure to the sun, if the
- 7 product is regulated by the Federal Food and Drug Administration for over-the-counter use.
- 8 (b) For the purposes of this section only, sunscreen is not to be considered an over-the-
- 9 <u>counter medication.</u>
- 10 (c) Nothing in this section requires school personnel to assist pupils in applying
- 11 sunscreen. Nothing in this section shall make the school district or its personnel liable for any
- 12 <u>damages under this section.</u>
- 13 (d) The school district may encourage schools to educate pupils on sun safety
- 14 precautions.
- 15
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
