- SECTION 1. Section 11-41-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-41 entitled "Theft,
- 2 Embezzlement, False Pretenses, and Misappropriation" is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 11-41-8. Stealing of animals.
- 4 (a) Every person who shall steal or attempt to steal any horse, pet or other domestic
- 5 animal shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year five (5) years or by a fine
- of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both; in case a
- 7 fine is imposed, one-half (1/2) shall inure to the use of the complainant.
- 8 (b) For the purpose of this section, "pet" shall have the same meaning as defined in § 4-
- 9 <u>13-1.2.</u>
