- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 9-17 of the General Laws entitled "Witnesses" is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>9-17-26. Privileged communications Interpreters and limited English proficient</u>
- 4 (LEP) persons.
- Whenever a limited English proficient (LEP) interpreter is used to facilitate a confidential
- 6 communication which is privileged pursuant to either statutory or common law, the limited
- 7 English proficient (LEP) interpreter shall not be compelled to testify in any forum in any civil or
- 8 <u>criminal action regarding that communication.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
