It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows: 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-12-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-12 entitled "Minimum 2 Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 **28-12-3. Minimum wages.** 4 (a) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees: commencing July 1, 1999, 5 at least the minimum wage of five dollars and sixty-five cents (\$5.65) per hour. Commencing September 1, 2000, the minimum wage is six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour. 6 (b) Commencing January 1, 2004, the minimum wage is six dollars and seventy-five 7 8 cents (\$6.75) per hour. (c) Commencing March 1, 2006, the minimum wage is seven dollars and ten cents 9 10 (\$7.10) per hour. (d) Commencing January 1, 2007, the minimum wage is seven dollars and forty cents 11 12 (\$7.40) per hour. 13 (e) Commencing January 1, 2013, the minimum wage is seven dollars and seventy-five 14 cents (\$7.75) per hour.

- 15 (f) Commencing January 1, 2014, the minimum wage is eight dollars (\$8.00) per hour.
- 16 (g) Commencing January 1, 2015, the minimum wage is nine dollars (\$9.00) per hour.
- 17 (h) Commencing January 1, 2016, the minimum wage is nine dollars and sixty cents 18 (\$9.60) per hour.
- 19 (i) Commencing January 1, 2018, the minimum wage is ten dollars and ten cents (\$10.10)

- 1 per hour. 2 (j) Commencing January 1, 2019, the minimum wage is ten dollars and fifty cents 3 (\$10.50) per hour. (k) Commencing January 1, 2020, the minimum wage shall be increased by an amount 4 5 equal to the total percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) published by the United States Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics for the 6 7 Northeast Region for the four (4) previous fiscal years, but in no event to exceed twelve percent <u>(12%).</u> 8
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
