It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 4-19 of the General Laws entitled "Animal Care" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
 - 4-19-11.4. Use of animals in medical school training.
- 4 (a) A medical school may not use a live animal in the medical education or training of
- 5 their students if there is an alternate teaching method that:
- 6 (1) Teaches its chosen medical procedure or lesson without the use of a live animal; and
- 7 (2) Is used by at least one other accredited medical school in the state.
- 8 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a
- 9 misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for
- 10 <u>each animal used.</u>

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
