RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS -- MINIMUM WAGES

Introduced By: Representatives Blazejewski, Shanley, Barros, Cassar, and Ranglin-Vassell

Referred To: House Labor

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 28-12 of the General Laws entitled "Minimum Wages" is hereby
2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **28-12-3.3. Minimum wages for health care workers.**

4 Commencing July 1, 2019, every covered health care employer with eighteen (18) or
5 more employees that either receives five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) or more in funding
6 annually from the state or pays an executive one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more annually in
7 total compensation shall pay each of its employees no less than fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF

RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS -- MINIMUM WAGES

1 This act would provide that every health care employer with at least eighteen (18)
2 employees, that either receives five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) or more in funding
3 annually from the state or pays an executive one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or more annually in
4 total compensation shall pay no less than fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour to each employee.

5 This act would take effect upon passage.
