She was a passionate sports fan who loved to sit on the porch and watch her beloved Boston Red Sox, New England Patriots and Notre Dame Football Team; and WHEREAS, Mrs. Picard leaves behind her children, Roland Picard and his wife, Mary, Richard Picard, Jeanne Debroisse and her husband, Maurice, Pauline Hoppe and her husband, Daniel, the Honorable Roger Picard, our friend and colleague who has served with honor and distinction in both the Rhode Island Senate and the Rhode Island House of Representatives, and his wife, Diane, and Claire Miller and her husband, John.
