It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows: 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-12-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-12 entitled "Minimum 2 Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 **28-12-3. Minimum wages.** 4 (a) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees: commencing July 1, 1999, 5 at least the minimum wage of five dollars and sixty-five cents (\$5.65) per hour. Commencing September 1, 2000, the minimum wage is six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour. 6 (b) Commencing January 1, 2004, the minimum wage is six dollars and seventy-five 7 8 cents (\$6.75) per hour. (c) Commencing March 1, 2006, the minimum wage is seven dollars and ten cents 9 10 (\$7.10) per hour. (d) Commencing January 1, 2007, the minimum wage is seven dollars and forty cents 11 12 (\$7.40) per hour. 13 (e) Commencing January 1, 2013, the minimum wage is seven dollars and seventy-five 14 cents (\$7.75) per hour. 15 (f) Commencing January 1, 2014, the minimum wage is eight dollars (\$8.00) per hour.

(g) Commencing January 1, 2015, the minimum wage is nine dollars (\$9.00) per hour.

(h) Commencing January 1, 2016, the minimum wage is nine dollars and sixty cents

(i) Commencing January 1, 2018, the minimum wage is ten dollars and ten cents (\$10.10)
