It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 37-2 of the General Laws entitled "State Purchases" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>37-2-82. State purchase of energy needs from renewable sources.</u>

- 4 (a) The state, through its purchasing policy and practice, shall establish a timetable
- 5 requiring increased utilization by the state of its energy needs from solar, on-shore wind, off-
- 6 <u>shore wind and any other distributed-generation technologies.</u>
- 7 (b) The timetable shall extend over a period of ten (10) years, until January 1, 2031, at
- 8 which time the state, including all its agencies and departments, shall be purchasing one hundred
- 9 percent (100%) of their energy needs from renewable sources.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

- 1 This act would require the state, including all its agencies and departments, to purchase
- 2 one hundred percent (100%) of their energy needs from renewable sources by January 1, 2031.
- 3 This act would take effect upon passage.
