- 4 Whenever in the opinion of the director any class of employers, either because of the nature
- 5 of their operations or their size, should be exempted from the provisions of this chapter, the director
- 6 may do so by regulations adopted in accordance with the provisions of § 25-3-6. All regulations
- 7 establishing exemptions adopted in accordance with the provisions of § 25-3-6 prior to July 1, 2021,
- 8 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
