It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Title 21 of the General Laws entitled "FOOD AND DRUGS" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following chapter:
- 3 **CHAPTER 27.2** 4 SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAWS 5 21-27.2-1. Definitions. As used in this chapter: 6 7 (1) "Food service establishment" shall have the meaning set forth in § 21-27-1. (2) "Single-use plastic straw" means a single-use, disposable tube made predominantly of 8 9 plastic derived from either petroleum or a biologically based polymer, such as corn or other plant 10 sources, used to transfer a beverage from a container to the mouth of the person drinking the beverage. "Single-use plastic straw" does not include a straw made from non-plastic materials, 11 12 including, but not limited to, paper, pasta, sugar cane, wood, or bamboo. 13 21-27.2-2. Prohibited practices exception. 14 A food service establishment shall not provide a single-use plastic straw to a consumer 15 unless requested by the consumer. 21-27.2-3. Penalties. 16 17 The first and second violations of this chapter shall result in a notice of violation, and any subsequent violation shall be punishable by a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each violation 18
- 19 by the service establishment, but not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300) annually.

1 <u>21-27.2-4. Enforcement.</u>

- 2 The director of health shall promulgate and adopt such rules and regulations as may be
- 3 <u>necessary to enforce the provisions of this chapter.</u>
 - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2022.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD AND DRUGS -- SINGLE-USE PLASTIC STRAWS

1 This act would prohibit a food service establishment from providing a consumer with a 2 single-use plastic straw, unless the consumer requests such a straw. The first and second violation 3 of this statute would result in a notice of violation, and any subsequent violations would be 4 punishable by a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300) 5 annually.

This act would take effect on January 1, 2022.
