It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11-37-2 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-37 entitled "Sexual
- 2 Assault" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>11-37-2. First degree sexual assault.</u>
- 4 A person is guilty of first degree sexual assault if he or she engages in sexual penetration
- 5 with another person, and if any of the following circumstances exist:
- 6 (1) The accused, not being the spouse, knows or has reason to know that the victim is
- 7 mentally incapacitated, mentally disabled, or physically helpless.
- 8 (2) The accused uses force or coercion.
- 9 (3) The accused, through concealment or by the element of surprise, is able to overcome
- 10 the victim.
- 11 (4) The accused engages in the medical treatment or examination of the victim for the
- 12 purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, or stimulation.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
