It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5-37-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-37 entitled "Board of
  Medical Licensure and Discipline" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 5-37-8. Grounds for discipline without hearing.

The director may temporarily suspend the license of a physician or limited registrant without a hearing if the director finds that evidence in his or her possession indicates that a physician's or limited registrant's continuation in practice would constitute an immediate danger to the public. In the event that the director temporarily suspends the license of a physician or limited registrant without a hearing, a hearing by the board must be held within ten (10) days after <u>the day</u> the suspension has occurred, <u>excluding intervening days when the department is closed</u>.

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SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
