It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-47-35.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled "Weapons"

2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **11-47-35.1. Persons exempt from § 11-47-35.**

4 The provisions of § 11-47-35 shall not apply to full-time members of the state police, full-
5 time members of the Rhode Island capitol police, full-time law enforcement officers within the
6 department of public safety, ~~full-time members of the state marshal's office,~~ full-time members of
7 city or town police departments ~~, or state marshals~~ or correctional officers or persons licensed under
8 § 11-47-11.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
