It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-4 of the General Laws entitled "State Emblems" is hereby
2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
3 **42-4-23. State fossil.**
4 The trilobite, a fossilized marine animal commonly found in Rhode Island, is hereby
5 designated the state fossil.
6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
