It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-44-12 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-44 entitled "Trespass

and Vandalism" is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-44-12. Injury to public property.

4 Every person who shall willfully cut or deface or otherwise injure any public building or

fence or other property shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) unless the amount

6 of damage exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100). If that amount shall exceed one hundred dollars

7 (\$100), then he or she shall be punished by a fine which is not less than three (3) times the amount

8 of the damage nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500), or imprisonment not exceeding one year,

or both, and, in addition to any sentence, shall be ordered to make restitution in the full amount of

10 damage done.
