It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 28-1 of the General Laws entitled "Department of Labor and
  Training" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

## 28-1-5. Digital credentialing.

4 Effective July 1, 2023, the department of labor and training ("department") shall require

5 publicly funded workforce and training programs to supplement all paper-based credentials with

- 6 verified electronic credentials. Credentials include, but are not limited to, certifications, licenses,
- 7 degrees, and training completion certificates issued by workforce and training programs within the
- 8 department's responsibility. An "electronic credential" means an electronic method by which a
- 9 person may display or transmit to another person information that verifies information about a
- 10 person such as their licensure, program completion, and verified skills and competencies. The
- 11 department may use a third-party electronic credential system that is not maintained by the agency.
- 12 Such electronic credential system shall include a verification system that is operated by the agency
- 13 or its agent on its behalf for the purpose of verifying the authenticity and validity of electronic
- 14 credentials.

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
