It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-22 of the General Laws entitled "Curriculum [See Title 16
2 Chapter 97 — the Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following section:

4 **16-22-39. Compulsory nutrition, food preparation and cooking courses.**

5 All public high schools in Rhode Island shall require all students to participate in a
6 nutrition, food preparation and cooking course annually.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
