It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6-13 of the General Laws entitled "Unfair Sales Practices" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

6-13-22. Digital coupons.

- 4 (a) Any business entity that is selling or offering goods for sale or services to a consumer,
- 5 <u>in-person or online, at retail that offers digital coupons shall make available to a consumer a paper</u>
- 6 <u>coupon of equal or identical value.</u>

- 7 (b) A digital coupon for the purposes of this section shall be defined as a store coupon,
- 8 rebate, or similar instrument that is offered to a consumer through an online platform, including,
- 9 <u>but not limited to, an app, website, or similar Internet forum.</u>
- (c) A violation of this section shall be subject to a two thousand five hundred dollar
- 11 (\$2,500) civil fine, for a first offense and a second and subsequent offenses shall be subject to a
- 12 five thousand dollar (\$5,000) civil fine.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on December 31, 2024.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL LAW -- GENERAL REGULATORY PROVISIONS --**UNFAIR SALES PRACTICES**

1 This act would require that a business entity that is selling goods or services at retail 2 offering a digital coupon to a consumer would also have to offer a paper coupon of identical value. A violation of this provision would result in a civil fine of \$2,500 for a first offense and \$5,000 for 3 4 a second and subsequent offense. This act would take effect on December 31, 2024. 5 LC003297
