CONGRATULATING THE LINCOLN HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION II GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THEIR SECOND STRAIGHT RHODE ISLAND STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

1 WHEREAS, The Lincoln Girls Basketball Team capped off an outstanding 26-1 regular 2 season record, including an 18 game winning streak and a perfect 16-0 record in their Division, 3 by repeating as State Champions; and 4 WHEREAS, Lincoln began their playoff run by crushing Tiverton 73-39 in the Quarterfinals and beating Burrillville 58-48 in a hard fought semi-final game, thanks in part to 5 6 Senior Bethany O'Dell's 24 points, 14 rebounds and 6 steals. With Lincoln clinging to a one point 7 43-42 lead with less than seven minutes remaining, Lincoln went on a clutch 11-0 run to put the 8 game away; and 9 WHEREAS, The Championship game against Barrington was expected to be a nail-biter 10 but instead turned into a 66-36 rout as Lincoln's three Seniors, Bethany O'Dell, Kelly Martin and 11 Erin Macro, dominated the game from start to finish. O'Dell, chosen State Tournament MVP for 12 the second year in a row, poured in 21 points, grabbed 16 rebounds and collected 8 assists. 13 Center Erin Macro contributed a game high 22 points along with 9 rebounds, while Senior Guard 14 Kelly Martin provided steady guidance and dished out 13 assists; and 15 WHEREAS, The Lincoln Girls Basketball Team was directed by new head coach Mike 16 Bedrossian and his wife, assistant coach Bethany Bedrossian. In sports, sometimes the hardest 17 thing for a coach to do is take over a winning program and maintain its winning tradition. Mike

and Bethany accomplished this difficult task and quickly gained the trust and confidence of the

team because they are talented basketball coaches, excellent teachers, and exemplary leaders; and
