- SECTION 1. Chapter 30-17.1 of the General Laws entitled "Veterans' Affairs" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 30-17.1-6.1. Veterans' assistance coordinator. (a) The director of the department of
- 4 human services shall appoint a coordinator in the division of veterans' affairs to assist veterans in
- 5 the filing of claims applications, to assist widows of veterans with applications for widow's
- 6 pension benefits, and to assist and coordinate the transportation of veterans in need of medical
- 7 <u>care between the Providence veterans' hospital and the veterans' home.</u>
- 8 (b) The coordinator shall be a full-time state employee with compensation in the amount
- 9 of thirty-thousand dollars (\$30,000) or more depending upon the qualifications of the individual
- 10 employed.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
