It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-19.1 of the General Laws entitled "Pharmacies" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>5-19.1-32. Prescription labels and literature for persons who are blind or visually</u>
- 4 **impaired.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary contained in any general or
- 5 public law, rule or regulation, upon request by any person who is blind or visually impaired, the
- 6 pharmacy shall provide prescription labels and accompanying literature in an enlarged font,
- 7 <u>Braille or tactile format.</u>
  - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
