It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-24 of the General Laws entitled "Children with Disabilities" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>16-24-19. Burden of production and proof. The party who filed for an impartial due</u>
- 4 process hearing pursuant to 34 CFR Section 300.507 et seq. has the burden of going forward with
- 5 the evidence. In all cases, however, the public agency has the burden of proving the
- 6 appropriateness of the child's program or placement, or of the program or placement proposed by
- 7 the public agency. This burden shall be met by a preponderance of the evidence.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION -- CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

1 This act would require that the party who files for an impartial due process hearing 2 pursuant to 34 CFR Section 300.507 et seq. has the burden of going forward with the evidence 3 and the public agency has the burden of proving the appropriateness of the child's program or 4 placement or the proposed program or placement. The burden to be met is a preponderance of the evidence. 5 6

This act would take effect upon passage.
