## RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- PASSING, USE OF LANES, AND RULES OF THE ROAD

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 31-15 of the General Laws entitled "Passing, Use of Lanes, and

Rules of the Road" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

31-15-19. Two-way left turn lanes. – A two-way left turn lane may be designated near

the center of a roadway for use by vehicles making left turns in both directions from or into the

5 <u>roadway.</u>

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6 (1) Two-way left turn lanes shall be designated by distinctive roadway markings

7 consisting of parallel double yellow lines, interior line dashed and exterior line solid on each side

8 of the lane. The department of transportation may determine and prescribe standards and

9 specifications governing length, width, and positioning of the distinctive pavement markings. All

pavement markings designating a two-way left turn lane shall conform to the department of

11 <u>transportation's standards and specifications.</u>

12 (2) A vehicle shall not be driven in a designated two-way left turn lane except when

13 preparing for or making a left turn from or into a highway or when preparing for or making a U-

14 turn when otherwise permitted by law, and shall not be driven in that lane for more than two

15 <u>hundred feet (200') while preparing for and making the turn or while preparing to merge into the</u>

16 adjacent lanes of travel. A left turn or U-turn shall not be made from any other lane where a two-

way left turn lane has been designated.

(3) This section shall not prohibit driving across a two-way left turn lane.

1	(4) Raised pavement markers may be used to simulate painted lines described in this
2	section when such markers are placed in accordance with standards established by the department
3	of transportation.
4	(5) Upon any vehicle entering the turn lane, no other vehicle proceeding in the opposite
5	direction shall enter that turn lane if that entrance would prohibit the vehicle already in the lane
6	from making the intended turn.
7	(6) When vehicles enter the turn lane proceeding in opposite directions, the first vehicle
8	to enter the lane shall have the right-of-way.
9	(7) Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in section 31-41.1-4.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
