It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-40 of the General Laws entitled "Private Schools" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>16-40-10.3. Rhode Island school of osteopathic medicine. -- Notwithstanding any rule.</u>
- 4 regulation, or general law to the contrary Rhode Island School of Osteopathic Medicine shall be
- 5 authorized to grant doctor of osteopathic medicine (D.O.) degrees provided that it is in
- 6 compliance with regulations and standards for approval adopted by the board of governors for
- 7 <u>higher education.</u>
