It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 27-19-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 27-19 entitled "Nonprofit
2	Hospital Service Corporations" is hereby repealed.

4	be engaged to solicit subscribers to any nonprofit hospital service plan upon a commission basis
5	or upon any other basis by which the payment of the compensation or expenses of that person
6	shall be conditioned upon the enrollment of subscribers, unless the method of solicitation and rate
7	of compensation shall have had the prior written approval of the insurance commissioner.
8	SECTION 2. Section 27-20-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 27-20 entitled "Nonprofit
9	Medical Service Corporations" is hereby repealed.
10	27-20-10. Commission plans for solicitors or insurance producers No person shall
11	be engaged to solicit subscribers to any nonprofit medical service plan upon a commission basis
12	or upon any other basis by which the payment of the compensation or expenses of the person
13	shall be conditioned upon the enrollment of subscribers, unless the method of solicitation and rate
14	of compensation shall have had the prior written approval of the director of business regulation.
15	SECTION 3. Section 27-20.1-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 27-20.1 entitled
16	"Nonprofit Dental Service Corporations" is hereby repealed.
17	27-20.1-6. Commission plans for solicitors or insurance producers No person shall
18	be engaged to solicit subscribers to any nonprofit dental service plan upon a commission basis or
19	upon any other basis by which the payment of the compensation or expenses of that person shall

- 1 be conditioned upon the enrollment of subscribers, unless the method of solicitation and rate of
- 2 compensation shall have had the prior written approval of the director of business regulation.
