It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 31-22 of the General Laws entitled "Miscellaneous Rules" is
  hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>31-22-28.1. Dogs prohibited from sitting on lap of operator of motor vehicle. -- It</u>
- 4 shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle with a dog sitting in the lap of the
- 5 motor vehicle operator. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this section shall, upon
- 6 conviction, be subject to a fine of eighty-five dollars (\$85.00); for a second conviction shall be
- 7 subject to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100); and for a third and subsequent convictions a
- 8 person shall be subject to a fine of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125). All violations arising
- 9 out of this section shall be heard in the Rhode Island Traffic Tribunal.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
