It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5-45-8 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-45 entitled "Nursing
- 2 Home Administrators" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>5-45-8. Licensure in other jurisdictions. --</u> The department may issue a nursing home
- 4 administrator's license without examination, to any person who holds a current license in good
- 5 standing as a nursing home administrator from another jurisdiction; provided, that the department
- 6 finds that the individual meets education and experience requirements as established by the
- 7 department regulation. For purposes of this section the department shall treat an applicant's
- 8 experience in a management position having direct responsibility for overseeing and directing a
- 9 <u>number of licensed nursing home administrators as equivalent to experience as an administrator</u>
- of a licensed long-term care facility.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
