BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - MISCELLANEOUS RULES

- 1 This act would amend the sunset provision of the statute passed in 2011 which provides
- 2 that violation of the seat belt law would be a primary offense.
- 3 This act would repeal the 2011 amendments on June 30, 2012 rather than June 30, 2013.
- 4 Seat belt violations occurring after June 30, 2012 would revert to a secondary offense.
 - This act would take effect upon passage.
