It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 39-2 of the General Laws entitled "Duties of Utilities and Carriers" 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 39-2-2.1. International telephone service. – (a) Any telecommunication company doing business in Rhode Island shall provide the following information to all customers making 4 5 international phone calls from a Rhode Island telephone service: 6 (1) The customer shall be informed that an international telephone call may cost an 7 additional surcharge or fee to their phone service bill; and 8 (2) The caller shall be advised that separate telephone service plans may be available that 9 offer reduced rates for international telephone service. 10 (b) This information may be provided by an actual customer service representative or a pre-recorded warning that is delivered prior to the international call being connected to the 11 12 recipient.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
