It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16-2-33.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-2 entitled "School 2 Committees and Superintendents" is hereby amended to read as follows: 16-2-33.1. City of Woonsocket -- School dress code School dress code. -- The 3 4 Woonsocket Any school committee, in conjunction with the superintendent, may adopt a school 5 dress code for Woonsocket its elementary, middle and high school students; provided, that: 6 (1) the The principal, staff and parents have had an opportunity to offer suggestions and 7 comments; 8 (2) the The dress code shall be adopted at a time determined by the school committee, 9 and the school committee shall give notice to the parents three (3) months before a dress code is 10 required; and 11 (3) that That on days when a nationally recognized youth organization has a scheduled 12 function students participating in this organization shall be exempt from the dress code on that 13 day-; and 14 (4) A dress code may include school uniforms.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
