RECOGNIZING MARCH 12-18, 2012, AS NATIONAL MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS AWARENESS WEEK IN THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND

1	WHEREAS, Multiple Sclerosis currently afflicts more than 400,000 Americans and more
2	than 2 million people worldwide; and
3	WHEREAS, Most people are diagnosed between the ages of 20 and 50, and Multiple
4	Sclerosis is 3 times more common in women than men; and
5	WHEREAS, Multiple Sclerosis is an unpredictable disease of the central nervous system
6	that can cause blurred vision, loss of balance, poor coordination, slurred speech, tremors,
7	numbness, extreme fatigue, problems with memory and concentration, paralysis, blindness, and
8	more; and
9	WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society, through individual gifts, legacies
10	and bequests, special events, and corporate contributions, is dedicated to finding a cure for this
11	disease through research efforts and support for those that suffer from it; and
12	WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society maintains an office in Warwick to
13	offer vital support and programs to those living with multiple sclerosis and their family members;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, The people of Rhode Island are similarly committed to the eradication of
16	this disease and support the treatment of fellow citizens that suffer from it; and
17	WHEREAS, This Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
18	encourages private efforts to enhance research funding and education programs that address these
19	diseases; now, therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations 2 hereby joins with the National Multiple Sclerosis Society in designating the week of March 12-18, 3 2012, as National Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Week to enhance the understanding of multiple 4 sclerosis, and to encourage participation in voluntary activities to support the local programs and 5 services offered by the National Multiple Sclerosis Society – Rhode Island Chapter, and the 6 funding of research programs to find a cure for this disease; and be it further 7 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and he hereby is authorized and directed to

8 transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to the Warwick office of the National Multiple
9 Sclerosis Society.
