It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-47-58 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled "Weapons"
- 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>11-47-58. Firearms -- State preemption</u> Firearms. -- The control of firearms, 4 ammunition, or their component parts regarding their ownership, possession, transportation, 5 carrying, transfer, sale, purchase, purchase delay, licensing, registration, and taxation shall rest 6 solely with the state, except as otherwise provided in this chapter city or town wherein the license 7 <u>was issued</u>.

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
