- 42-28.2-8.3. Educational requirements. Crisis intervention training. All municipal 4
- 5 police departments shall implement crisis intervention training within three (3) years. The police
- departments may utilize in house, service or professional development money, time or trained 6
- professionals within the police department to accomplish this requirement. 7
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
