It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 16-40 of the General Laws entitled "Private Schools" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

16-40-10.3. Rhode Island school of osteopathic medicine. -- Notwithstanding any rule,
regulation, or general law to the contrary Rhode Island School of Osteopathic Medicine shall be
authorized to grant doctor of osteopathic medicine (D.O.) degrees provided that it is in
compliance with regulations and standards for approval adopted by the board of governors for
higher education.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
