It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9-29-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-29 entitled "Fees" is 2 hereby amended to read as follows: 9-29-18. Superior court fees. -- (a) The superior court shall be allowed the following 3 4 fees in full to be taxed in the bill of costs in every civil action: 5 (1) For entry of every civil action, or petition \$160.00 \$200.00 6 (2) For every writ of execution \$50.00 7 (3) For the issuance of every citation \$25.00 8 (b) In addition to the fees set forth in subsection (a) of this section, a surcharge shall be 9 placed on all filing fees. 10 (c) Provided, that ten dollars (\$10.00) twenty dollars (\$20.00) of the fee for the entry of 11 every civil action or petition shall be forwarded to Rhode Island Legal Services. 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. _____

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS AND CIVIL PROCEDURE - SUPERIOR COURT FEES

This act would increase the Superior Court filing fee for civil cases from one hundred sixty dollars (\$160) to two hundred dollars (\$200) and the portion of that fee that is forwarded to Rhode Island legal services from ten dollars (\$10.00) to twenty dollars (\$20.00).

This act would take effect upon passage.
